"There will be a clash with government authorities and with the society if the society insists on moving away from the roots of Christianity that our forefathers fought so hard to bring about."

He continued with a reminder about Hitler and the people who did not speak out against him.

Pat Robertson

"It's far better to die for the truth than to compromise for a lie."

--Robertson talked about the assault on Christians especially during this time (the week of Seven Days Ablaze) and the assault on Jesus, one example being the movie "The Last Temptation of Christ." Mentioned that some cable stations especially Cinemax and HBO, were showing the movie starting tonight. He encouraged callers to call cable owners (Time, Inc.) and gave listeners the phone number.

"The feature of the bill is that the liberals have said that the Christians, the churches, the religious organizations can't share one dime of it."

Robertson called for prayer for a miracle to defeat this bill.

In stating that family day care in a home environment is best, Robertson said "this bill will cut all this out, I think."

In his prayer he said, "Father,...little children in our country

look like they may be wards of the state..."

He is the high priest receiving what comes from the Lord."

Special segment on founding fathers and their view of the United States as a Christian nation. Quotes from an interview with James Kennedy identified as James Kennedy, Ph.D., colonial scholar. Robertson asserted how we must reestablish faith in God and self-reliance and the way to do that is to go back and study founding fathers statements. Decries how textbooks and historians lie to students. Christians can do several things including, register to vote; be informed on issues; the church must be united; and activists need to be trained.

**Pat Robertson**

"We have a trillion dollar a year budget and the government is spending money as it is in the billions of dollars to fund homosexual education types of programs...If they're funding Planned Parenthood, and they do, to the tune of about 100 million dollars a year. If they're funding all kinds of liberal left causes with your money. If they're going to set up ABC day care centers where you cannot have any church instruction, no religious instruction, and you're going to get little babies all the way through 5 or 6 years old and it's going to be under

government authority with humanists teaching them. If you're going to allow your taxpayer money to be used for funding new age doctrine. You can change that, but you've got to know how to lobby your legislature, you've got to know how to elect people, you've got to know how to make coalitions with others; you've got to know how to get off some of these extreme positions so that you come through as reasonable and moderate instead of some way-out right-wing kook."

Robertson puts in a plug for CBNU as a training center for the above plan and discusses how the proposed CBN conference center will facilitate this training. He discusses funds and uses and what happened to PTL Club and how it differs from CBN construction. Talks about how CBN gives money to local churches.

Special segment: Bush Administration and Evangelicals.

Pat accuses White House of a cover-up of Paul Pressler nomination. He claims that the White House said that they offered the job to Pressler but he turned it down. Evangelicals voted 83% for Bush but have gotten nothing in return except three appointments. Statistics on Bush appointments.

Quotes from interviews with Paige Patterson, Criswell College; Chase Untermeyer, Bush administration; Doug Wead, White House Office of Public Liaison.

Patterson accuses Bush staff of sabotaging appointments and says maybe evangelicals should back off of support of Bush. Narrator mentions Lee Atwater's alleged controversial quote regarding evangelicals.

Pat accuses administration officials of hidden agenda and sabotage. On Pressler, Pat says that the White House received 545 calls in favor and 9 calls opposed. Pat interviews Pat McGuigan, Free Congress Foundation on the lack of evangelicals in Bush administration. McGuigan claims that the response of evangelicals to being shut out should be to become more active

and to demand more. McGuigan talks about the need to put more of "our people" in positions of power. Pat encourages people to write and ask for more evangelical appointments and complain about lack of appointments. Gives address and phone number of White House.

News segment:

--San Francisco earthquake. Interview with Claire Rubin, research scientist, natural disasters, GWU. Interview with Bob Warren and Tom Victor, Operation Blessing and CBN officials about CBN response to earthquake. Tom Victor compared spiritual climate of today to that of San Francisco at the time of the 1906 earthquake. They are the responses of God to prayer and revival. Pat explained that 1st there was Hurricane Hugo, 2nd, the stock market crash, and 3rd, the earthquake. All of these are "early warning signals from God." The nation cannot keep doing what it's doing and get away with it.

"First of all the Supreme Court ruled that unborn babies weren't human beings under the Constitution and therefore we started an orgy of slaughter of our young..." [With Webster, the Supreme Court starts to back away but politicians are buckling under to pro-choice people in places like Florida] "At that point we have said, our judges are waffling on life, our politicians refuse to act and our people want to destroy unborn human life. And so God says 'alright, if you continue the slaughter of the innocent, I'm going to begin to slaughter you.'"

Robertson discussed Leviticus 18 where he says God gives examples of the kinds of conduct that would cause God to destroy a society. These sins (along with Robertson's comments) include:

1. incest (1/4 of all children are molested by family members).
2. child sacrifice (abortion).
3. adultery (at least 50% of adults admit to having affairs).
4. homosexuality (2 men in Congress who are acknowledged homosexuals; the teaching of homosexuality in schools; laws making homosexuality a protected lifestyle).
5. bestiality.

Robertson points out that four of these sins involve sex, not financial problems or lying before Congress because God doesn't care about these things, only sex. If the U.S. doesn't take care of these problems, then God will do it himself.

"Now that He's been cleaning up his church [Bakker, Swaggart], He can say, I've done it first to my people, now I'm going to do it to you."

Introduction of new segment on natural forces in universe called Genesis. Quote from Carl Sagan on creationists. Shows early scientists religious background and how science and philosophy have moved away from religion. Interviews with modern scientists on God's role in the universe.

"Last week, CBN News reported on President Bush's personnel appointments and the severe lack of evangelicals chosen to fill positions in his administration. Now, many of you responded with concern about that by calling the White House to voice your views. Correspondent Ken Lormand has an update on the president's appointments and the calls that came in."

Ken Lormand reported that Quayle, Sununu and others met with members of The Family Research Council to try to reassure them that the administration does want evangelicals in government. A spokesman said he knew of three evangelical presidential appointments. He also said that more meetings between White House officials and Christian leaders are likely. Lormand said that because of a 700 Club report last week, the White House received 401 calls on the issue: 395 callers wanted more evangelicals in government; six were against the idea.

"Your calls and your letters are apparently making quite an impact in the White House." [Again gave out the number for the White House opinion line and encouraged people to call.]

"It looked as if the pro-life people were coming out with some losses and of course, they were trumpeted in the press, with glee it seemed like, all across the country, but you look at two major states like Michigan, a big state, and Pennsylvania, even

larger, and now the United States Congress not having the clout to override the veto...There's strong feeling in the country, way overwhelming majorities...But in any event, there are two northern, industrial states saying no to abortion, and that's very significant."

"Evolution's Bloops and Blunders"

D. James Kennedy

"Evolution has produced some incredible results in the twentieth century. It has been without doubt the most influential theory in the twentieth century. What has it produced? One, it produced Naziism. Darwin wrote a book, The Origin of Species and the Survival of Favored Races. It was but a small step for Hitler, who was a zealous evolutionist, to go



from the survival of the favored race to the dominance of the favored race.

"Mussolini continually spouted the evolutionary catch-words. He was a zealous evolutionist who mocked at the idea of peace as being something inimitable to evolution and that war would speed up the process of evolution, which was the highest goal in Mussolini's mind. Think of the desolation of the second world war. Is this a trifling matter?

"Or remember that Karl Marx was so enamored by evolution when he read Darwin's book that he felt he had discovered a scientific foundation for Communism. Since Communism and all other atheistic concepts do not believe in a creator, they are forced to a naturalistic evolutionary explanation of the world.

"Not only do we have that...but we have humanism, secular humanism in America which is based firmly upon evolution...So we see, whether we're talking about Naziism or Fascism or Communism or humanism that evolution is the singular pillar which holds them all up.

"More than that, what else has happened in this century? We have in our own country and around the world, a tremendous sexual revolution that is taking place, where anything goes. First, we saw there was pornography, and then there was incest and homosexuality, and now we find bestiality as well, and every kind of sexual immorality...

"Famous scientists around the world are awakening to the fallacy. They are calling it a fairy tale, a myth, stories ingeniously concocted, a hoax perpetrated on the youth of the world. The results of this have been disastrous."
