"Has President Clinton defied God with his recent executive decrees? Well, first of all, he has now ordered all military hospitals to begin performing abortions for military personnel, upon request, at the taxpayer's expense. He has also lifted the ban on abortion counseling at all tax-funded clinics. Likewise, the President has now legalized the use of fetal tissue for medical research, which many fear will cause little teenage girls to sell their unborn babies for money. The President has likewise declared his support for RU 486. This is that do-it-yourself abortion kit that was created in France which will undoubtedly kill untold millions of little unborn babies. He has

also declared that he will lift the ban on gays in the military in defiance of all military counsel and advice over the past 217 years of history. Likewise he has pledged support for a new homosexual rights bill which would establish homosexuals as a bonafide minority. In the New York City public schools, for example, they are now teaching six-year-old children that homosexuality and lesbianism are acceptable alternate lifestyle in spite of the protest from thousands of parents."

### **Coral Ridge Hour 2-28-93**

Kennedy's sermon, titled "The Separation of Church and State," served as a criticism of that concept in American political life.

#### **D. James Kennedy**

"What was it that those who founded this nation intended for us to have? Was it a secular nation, a godless nation? Or was it indeed a Christian nation? This is a question which indeed is very, very significant in our day... Many people today, coming through our public education system, are totally unaware of the extent of the Christian foundation of America. But listen to the facts, and you make up your mind."

- Kennedy offers a brief history of the original settlers in America, quoting their intentions to further Christianity in the New World.

"If we get rid of the concept of inalienable rights given by God, than we lose the very foundation of our liberties which were established in the Declaration. And that is why the evolutionary teaching of our time is so dangerous to the basic liberties that we enjoy. Do you not see that if man was not created by God, if, rather, he merely evolved, by some concatenation of amino acids and molecules in an ancient sea, then he has no inalienable rights... without belief in a creator, there are no absolute and inalienable rights. Therefore, every school classroom which is undermining the concept of creation is indeed undermining the basis of our liberties and our rights."

"[quoting the Supreme Court] This is a religious people. This is a Christian nation. Let me say that again. In the Trinity decision, in the 1890's, the Supreme Court of the United States said, 'this is a Christian nation.'"

"[Separation of Church and State] does not accurately represent

what the First Amendment says.... I am sure that if the People for the American Way, so-called, were the ones who were founding this country today, that not one single such [religious] sentiment, as all of these dozens or scores as I have mentioned today, would be found in our national heritage. Yet these people do not, let me say it again -- do not -- represent the American Way, they represent a total departure from the historic American Way, clearly indicated by all of the documents and even officially stated by the Supreme Court of this land. Let us not be further deceived by them. I believe that the time has long past for Christians to stand on their feet and say, 'thus far, and no farther. We have had enough of this.' We can no longer allow such movements as these to reduce this nation to a secularistic, humanistic, atheistic state where all of our rights and freedoms are reduced to simply the whim of the state either to grant them or withdraw them as they wish."

"I hope that you will get a copy of this material and that you will give this information to many of your friends who do not understand, who have been misled and brainwashed into believing that this is... anything but a Christian nation."
