Falwell's sermon was called, "Our Children must be told: America is a Christian nation!" Following are relevant quotations:

"This great nation is a Christian nation, and that from its inception our founders intended it to be so."

Falwell offered a book, "The Myth of Separation," as a premium for a donation.

"Our children need to be reminded that this nation was founded by Godly men and women who were believers in and followers of Jesus Christ and who came here to establish a Christian nation."

"Since 1947 in Everson vs. Board of Education, the Supreme Court and all the courts have just reversed everything the founding fathers had intended."

"The Supreme Court... either cannot read or write, or worse, they can, and they want to change what America is."

"This, America, is a Christian nation."

"Our founders gave us a Christian nation."

"The founders were committed to the Christian religion."

"I can't imagine anything as insane as introducing in to your community diseased refugees who have a highly infectious disease which kills people."

- Bill in Congress will help states expand "Parents as Teachers" programs which will help pre-schoolers prepare for school.

"Does that mean that the government is going to come into the homes and tell you how to raise your pre-school children

before you enter them into school?"

The report criticized the program because it allows the government to designate a family "at-risk." Program supporters say that portion of the program has been removed.

Jerry Falwell

"A Christian feminist to me is like saying 'a Christian evolutionist' or 'a Christian prostitute.' They are a contradiction in terms."

"Feminism is anti-Christian."

Falwell's sermon this week was titled, "Why True Christian Women Do Not Participate in the Feminist Movement." Following are other relevant quotations:

"Will these feminists, who do not represent the American women, succeed in the passage of a new homosexual and lesbian [sic] civil rights legislation?"

"An assistant secretary in the president's Cabinet right now is a feminist who lives with her female lover, and they're raising a seven-year-old son right in the White House."

Falwell offered the transcript of today's message for a \$35 donation.

"Most of these feminists are radical, frustrated lesbians -- many of them -- and man-haters, and failures in their relationships with men, who have declared war on the male gender. The Biblical condemnation of feminism has to do with its radical philosophy and goals. That's the bottom line."

"A woman certainly should have reproductive freedom. We believe

that. We simply believe that she should exercise that freedom before she goes to bed."

"They have these meetings, you know. They counsel, they get together and they think, 'how can we con the public? What is the best way to con the American public into thinking we're nice people? Because the media has agreed they'll help us,' because the media is as big a bunch of jerks as the feminists are."

"Their goal is to humiliate men, to put women in all positions of power and authority because they simply don't like men."

Falwell listed feminist organizations: NOW, Planned Parenthood, NARAL, People for the American Way, the ACLU, the National Education Association, Bill and Hillary Clinton, the American entertainment industry, the national news media, public education.

"And then there's Norman Lear's People for the American Way. They were started back in the early eighties to oppose evangelical Christians and Moral Majority, and Norman Lear funded and it's still going on. It's just a little office up there, two or three people, they get a lot of press and they have different people running it from time to time."

"Just a few short months ago Bill Clinton thought his biggest problem was Jennifer Flowers. But now it turns out it's his wife Hillary, with whom he's trying to conduct a co-presidency, except he's on the short end of the 'co' right now... and now as her aggressive feminism reveals itself on television, the more we see of Hillary the better we like Barbara Bush. You remember the cookie gaffe, which illustrates Hillary's personality quite clearly. Instead of responding factually to a question about conflict of interest with her law firm and the governor's office in Arkansas, she answered with a typical feminist response: a put-down of full-time housekeepers and homemakers."

"God made the woman a 'help meet,' she is a 'help meet.'"

"To be a feminist, a person must reject the literal teaching of the Bible."

"Feminist philosophy is a big lie. Satan is in the business of telling big lies."

"They've asked for the kind of equality that God never intended."

"How may the church defeat and eliminate feminism? Well, the first place to begin, I do believe with my heart, is to win young people to Christ."

Falwell's sermon discussed the expelling of God from America's public life. Following are some quotations:

Jerry Falwell

"We have federal judges, we have a Congress, we have national entertainers, we even have a president today who are [sic] committed to defying God's laws. For example, our President recently expressed his support for the Freedom of Choice Act, called FOCA. It will eliminate all restrictions on abortion in all fifty states in all three trimesters of pregnancy, for any reason, or no reason at all. He has given his support for RU 486. That's a French abortion pill; that's a do-it-yourself abortion kit that will allow young girls to get pregnant and take a pill, like an aspirin, to destroy the child, and do it again, do it again [sic]. It will cost millions of little babies their lives. Our president has said he's going to lift the ban on gays in the military, and that flies into the face of God, who said that homosexuality is [an] abomination. He has made appointments to high places in the government of lesbians, homosexual persons, and God said that's wrong. My friends, if we Christians do not stand up right now and do something about what's happening in our schools and public life and the government, I believe the hand of God will fall upon this great nation in judgement."

"There is no separation of church and state. Modern U.S. Supreme Courts have raped the Constitution and raped the Christian faith and raped the churches by misinterpreting what the founders had in mind in the first amendment of the Constitution."

Falwell was again selling "The Myth of Separation," a book by David Barton, which refutes the idea of Separation of Church and State.

"You need to share the facts with your children and grandchildren that this is a Christian nation. The nation was founded with that in mind: a Christian nation. And we must fight against those radical minorities who are trying to remove God from our textbooks, Christ from our nation. We must never allow our children to forget that this is a Christian nation. We must take back what is rightfully ours."

Falwell's sermon was titled, "America must return to the faith of our fathers."

"My focus is to see a spiritual renaissance, an awakening, a revival in America that will restore a generation of young people to the faith of our fathers. Boy, that includes massive reeducation, that includes a massive resistance against those radical minorities who are committed to making this one nation without God, a pagan nation."

"I hope the members of Congress are watching. We are on in Washington, D.C. I hope the president, and particularly Hillary, are [sic] watching. I hope that the Supreme Court is watching. I hope that members of state legislatures are watching and listening."

"Let everyone know that this Separation of Church and State business is bogus."

"Where did these heathen jurists come from?"

"Now you Congressmen ought to take that seriously. Accessory to the disorders you cause [by ignoring the Bible]. Mr. President, you are an accessory to the disorders you are causing."

"Those persons who reject America's Christian heritage are accountable to God."

"Now our 42nd President and his 'Mother Superior,' Hillary, and all those around him have determined under God that we're going to change the rules. We're not going to be a nation under God anymore."

"He has legalized the use of fetal tissue for medical research, which will lead -- without question -- little girls to become pregnant and sell their unborn babies for money."

"All Americans will be punished for the ungodly actions of our leaders. We will pay the price for what the Supreme Court and the Congress and the president and others do as our leaders. I'm often asked by the press, 'do you believe that AIDS is the judgement of God upon homosexuals?' I always answer, 'no. I believe that it is the judgement of God upon the entire American society for embracing and endorsing what God has condemned, namely moral perversion.' And I say the same for other venereal diseases."

"I believe that natural calamities and national calamities and AIDS and venereal diseases and all these terrible things that are happening to us today are God's judgement upon us as a nation for defying his laws. And there's no way to deny that."

"Our judges and political counselors must return to a respect for God, and respect for the Bible, and a respect for the Biblical values which their predecessors held."

"We must reclaim our public schools. We must not give up our schools. We must stand up and fight for them. And I told you last week, get on the school boards, run for election, get on the city council. Attend the PTA meetings. Get into the textbook controversy."

"We have got to put good men and women in government who love God, who believe in Biblical principles, and who follow the will of God for their lives."

Kennedy gave a "special report" on this show, titled, "Taking Liberties: the Legacy of the ACLU."

Kennedy went through the history of the ACLU, from its start in 1920 through the present. He quoted the policy manual of the ACLU, which he says differs greatly from the intentions of the founders. He criticizes them as radical, with roots in Communism.

"And then right after that [hurricane Hugo], the San Francisco earthquake. You can say what you want to, but if you look at the Old Testament, natural disasters were viewed as a sign of God's displeasure, and the blessing of God was the rain and the warmer seasons and enough water to plant crops, etcetera. It just seems to me that this nation of ours is beginning to be shaken by a God who is trying to say to us, 'pay attention, you're doing things that are wrong.'"

"We prayed in 1964 and one was diverted, we haven't had a

hurricane since. Well, God has spared an area because of prayer. And when God puts a mantle of protection across a nation, and they are spared some of the effects of natural disasters. If he lifts his hand of protection, then we're at the mercy of the elements like everybody else. This has been a nation favored by God. All he has to do is lift his hand of protection, and that is what's happening. Why should God give a hand of protection to the United States when we slaughter babies, when we deny his word, when we blaspheme his name, when we do things that are completely wrong and contrary to his word and then we laugh at him. Why should God take care of us as if we're a Christian nation? A governor of Mississippi said we're a Christian nation. He was set upon by the press, and his fellow Republicans and other governors said, 'how dare you say this is a Christian nation?' Okay, so we're not a Christian nation. That means that God doesn't have to look after us anymore. It that's what you want, okay. You tell God to go away, then, and we'll have it this way. Twenty-five billion dollars in insurance costs just in one hurricane."

"I was up in Korea, and when you're up in a combat

situation, if you get a shower it's a big communal tent, and everything is communal. The thought that one among you has a different orientation -- or two or three -- it gets to be very disconcerting. When you've got to go fight the enemy, or make sure the plans are right so that the division marches on time, and you're splitting your time between your mission and warding off whatever is going on among you -- now it's a question of AIDS, I mean good grief. Do we want to bring all these -- and then you're looking at their so-called lovers and associates, and so the question is: is the United States government not only going to take a homosexual in the military, but is the United States government then responsible for his ill housemate, or whatever they call themselves? It's a major problem, and Sam Nunn is absolutely right to oppose it. He is a very good senator, and he's a Democrat, and he's a very prominent man and he's standing against it, and I think a lot of others will too."

"You can't come out as a non-profit and say, 'vote for candidate X.' The IRS won't let you do that. I think we need participation, because if the pro-family Roman Catholics, the evangelical Christians and many of the conservative Jewish people in the country get together -- people of faith -- we can elect anybody in this onrush."

Homosexuality is deviant activity which the Bible says is a mortal sin. The Bible says very clearly: no homosexual will enter into the kingdom of heaven.... we do not want our kids to be taught in schools to become homosexuals and lesbians. We don't want that."
