The Old Time Gospel Hour
May 2, 1993

In today's sermon, Falwell answered the question, "What do Hollywood, Washington and Hell have in common?" Following are relevant quotations:

Jerry Falwell

HOLLYWOOD

"But the abominable, the whore mongers, and all liars -- that's Washington -- shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone; which is the second death."

"I want to speak today on three localities which, in my opinion, have a great deal in common: Hollywood, Washington and Hell."

"I think Hollywood hates America, and I sometimes think Washington hates America."

"Harvard should be ashamed of themselves for having such a barbarian [Ice-T] on their platform. If Ice-T ever showed up at Liberty University we'd arrest him for trespassing. We don't allow martians, or escaped fugitives, or Ice-T at Liberty University, and certainly not Madonna."

"The vast majority of them [in Hollywood] are subhuman in their behavior, conduct and philosophy. Sue me if I'm wrong."

"The soap operas -- I'm going to make some of you women mad on this one, but that's my intention. You have no business spending your afternoon in front of the television watching one bedroom scene after another, listening and watching material which does nothing but damage you as a Christian, a wife, and a mother. It destroys your values system, and it hurts your family. And if you love your children, you ought to stop watching it."

Falwell discussed the efforts of Dr. Richard Neill in Dallas, who worked to get sponsors to drop the Donahue show. He called on his viewers to do the same.

"We can change society if we care enough, if we pray enough, if we're willing to get involved."

WASHINGTON

"Washington is at war with God... the Supreme Court has virtually eliminated our Christian heritage from the public fabric of our country."

"There is no difference between the sacred and the secular with

God."

"I was raised a Democrat, I admit, and there was a time when I think that wasn't something to be so ashamed of. I'd be ashamed today if I were, with the platform they've got. There are some fine Democrats out there who don't know that their platform is anti-God, anti-life, anti-everything."

"In 1962 the brilliant, bright jurists on the Supreme Court decided, 'we know better what the founding fathers meant than they knew [sic].'"

"The Supreme Court has raped the Constitution in the past generation."

"Jesse Helms; now that's a statesman... Senator Jesse Helms sent us \$500 this week and he said, 'Keep on truckin'. I'm praying for you. Washington is going to Hell, but I'm praying for you. Keep on trucking.'"

"President Clinton is openly defying God and Judeo-Christian principles. That's the tragedy. I told you in recent weeks about his overturning the ban on gays in the military."

"I recommend to Christians all over America that you ought to ask your doctor before you continue giving him money, 'Are you pro-life? Are you against RU 486? Are you against abortion?' Chances are that you can probably find a physician in your town that is pro-life and does support Biblical principles. You ought to support, with your dollars, those kind of doctors."

"Byron White no sooner said, 'I'm retiring from the Supreme Court,' the President said, 'I'm looking for a pro-abortion replacement.'"

NEA

"In 1989 the National Endowment for the Arts indignantly denied a modest \$10,000 request from the New York Academy of Art to provide young painters with basic skills in representational drawing.... less than a year later the endowment paid \$70,000 in government funds -- your tax dollars and mine -- for a gallery show that featured Dawn Eichman's [sp?] "Alchemy Cabinet," displaying a jar with the bloody fetal remains from her own abortion. The federal arts administration has also found funds at the NEA to provide grants for performance artists such as John Fleck [sp?], whose act includes a sequence in which he publicly urinates on a picture of Christ. Your tax dollars and mine pay for that. And the outspoken Annie Sprinkle, who masturbates on stage with various sex toys and than invites members of the audience to explore her private parts with a flashlight. My tax dollars and yours. And I want to say to Mr. Clinton, I want to say to the NEA, I want to say to all that bunch of heathen up

there who promote this kind of thing that I'm against it, and we're not going to stop saying we're against it. It infuriates us. No wonder we have no confidence in Washington. You won't find anybody in Lynchburg who will do something that dirty and lowdown."

Falwell called on viewers to get informed, write letters to the editor, register to vote, become active, and take on a 'culprit' personally (TV shows, movies, etc.).

"It's all the almighty dollar. And that's what America is all about."

Today's message was titled, "It is not homophobic to oppose homosexuality." Falwell discussed gay rights, gays in the military, and the gay and lesbian march on Washington. He is selling a tape with footage from the march, "Expose of the Radical Gay and Lesbian Agenda." Following are relevant quotations:

Jerry Falwell

"On this videotape, you can see for yourself the carnival atmosphere created by the most radical group of perverts that ever visited our nation's capital."

"...the radical gay agenda to overturn everything good and decent in America."

"As we watched a crowd that the homosexuals said numbered one million march upon the nation's capital, it gave the appearance of a modern day Sodom and Gomorrah."

"A bigot is someone who has Biblical truth on their side and is not afraid to preach and deliver that truth, even against the mobs."

Falwell read the platform of the gay-lesbian-bi march.

"Those are code words. They want quota hiring."

"What they really want is to be allowed -- and the pedophiles are saying so -- to violate any child of any age, with no one able to do anything about it."

"It [tolerance of gays and lesbians] leads to a total breakdown of moral and family and spiritual values, under which this society, this Christian nation, was built."

He asked and answered the question, "how does one gain victory over homosexuality?"

"It was as if Sodom and Gomorrah had stepped off the pages of the Old Testament and visited our nation's capital."

Pat Robertson

"The weather is 'freaking out,' if you will. We call it freak weather. It is shaking this nation. Although it's hard to say this is the wrath of God -- I think that would be too strong a statement -- I do believe God is lifting his hand of protection from this great nation. Many times innocent people suffer. But we are permitting things to happen in our country that are an abomination, a stench in the nostrils of a holy God."

-- Is America still a Christian nation? America: a modern pagan nation. The report cited pagan influences in environmentalism and homosexuality.

Reporter

"The homosexual movement forging across America, as seen at the recent gay and lesbian march in Washington, is also laced with pagan practices and thinking."

The report also compared the rise of paganism to the rise of Nazism in Germany.

Pat Robertson

"The radical left does not like Christianity. They don't like the Bible, they don't like God, they don't like Jesus, and they don't like free market capitalism. They don't like any of these things!"

Pat Robertson

"Let me tell you, at a time like this, when there is natural disaster, the whole nation goes -- whole sections go -- it's not just you. This is what the Bible says, 'the land will vomit you out.' Read Leviticus, in chapter 18. Read in there, exactly -- and we're doing every one of those things that the heathen did when the land vomited them out. And this is America. But is it lost? No, it isn't. But we are lost without a compass. We have leadership without a compass, we have judges without a compass, we've got school authorities without compasses... let's pray. Let's mobilize God's people."

"The members of the Senate were here in our area in the Norfolk Naval Base yesterday inquiring about homosexuals in the military. And the sailors said, "no, no!" It was overwhelming. We don't want this to be forced on us by the government. We don't want this kind of aberration to be forced on us. Yet we have people in power in Washington saying they're going to force schools to teach this perversion. We're going to force the armed services to

accept this kind of lifestyle. We're going to force it into the colleges of America."

"The United States of America may not have more than seven years. It might not even have that many, it may only have three or four before the moral rot that has set into our society collapses the superstructure that makes for a good life for all of us, and we move into a second class status as a nation and everything begins to go downhill."

Pat claims that pro-life candidates will win in Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island and the Bronx. This program analyzed the "catastrophic effects" of the choice of abortion on a woman and her loved ones.

Pat Robertson

"Some of you have had abortions; some of you are contemplating abortions. You know something, it will tear you up, not only physically, but emotionally. And it will leave scars for the rest of your life on everybody around you. You'll never quite be the same again."

"One of the reasons so many lesbians are in the forefront of the pro-choice movement is because being a mother is the unique characteristic of womanhood, and these lesbians will never be mothers naturally. So they don't want anybody else to have that privilege either. You wonder why, at the barricades, they're shouting obscenities at people who are trying to encourage people to have babies, or at least not to abort babies. Why is that, that fierce anger? It is because motherhood is the ultimate evidence of femininity. When people say, 'I'm a feminist,' it's an oxymoron. You can't be a feminist without doing what women do, which is bearing children. That's the ultimate height of being a feminine person, so these lesbians don't like that... you'll find this group of radicals at the forefront of every anti-family initiative in our country."

Falwell's sermon was titled, "PC or JC: Political Correctness or Jesus Christ." Following are relevant quotations:

Jerry Falwell

"PC is political correctness. It is a disease which, like cancer, has spread throughout the educational systems in America."

"Today, from pre-school through university education, America's educational community has made a major change in direction. That change of direction is a commitment to rid America of its traditional values through the introduction of PC -- political correctness... the idea is to change the political views of an entire society."

[Falwell listed the four tenets of political correctness: 1. Affirm homosexuality as acceptable; 2. Be pro abortion; 3. Assert that American democracy is a failed system, and that we must create a socialist, one-world government.]

"PC is pagan."

"Outcome Based Education -- OBE -- will replace traditional education. The principle force producing politically correct education at the elementary and secondary levels is OBE... it is presented as a humanistic developmental approach... In the main, OBE is a strong curricular emphasis on politically correct issues which are almost always contrary to Biblical principles. So when you hear Outcome Based Education, watch out -- at the PTA or the school board meeting. When you hear Outcome Based Education -- OBE -- [it's a] bad word; anti-Christian, anti-Bible."

Old Time Gospel Hour
May 30, 1993

Falwell's sermon is titled, "The Desperate Need for Godly Mothers." He exposes the "latest effort by gays and lesbians to recruit your children to join their vulgar lifestyle," and the "anti-Biblical master plan of the White House for your children." Following are relevant quotations:

"Hillary thinks you're not capable of rearing your own children, so the White House has a plan that threatens to steal the minds of your child from the day care periods of pre-school times right on through college."

"Let me tell you something. On this videotape you can see for

yourself the carnival atmosphere created by the most radical group of perverts that ever visited our nations capital. Well organized. This is truly, in my opinion, a most tragic time in the history of our great nation."

[Sermon begins]

"Public education, the entertainment industry, government, the national media and much of the secular world are all in a conspiracy, it would appear, in a commitment to the indoctrination of America's children."

"America was founded as a Christian nation."

"We need godly mothers because New Age religion, with its emphasis on environmentalism and feminism is rampant."

"Feminism is anti-Christian."

"I've got a real problem with the modern environmentalists because, while they claim to be environmentalists when it comes to the spotted owl and the snail darter and the little animals in danger of becoming extinct, most of them are pro-choice when it comes to abortion. To me, that's hypocrisy. If you're for saving the little animals and for saving the trees and for saving the owls, then for God's sake be for saving the little babies."

"God made you as you are -- the minorities that I've just mentioned and others -- but a person is a moral pervert by choice and should not be rewarded for [sic] as a minority."

"The White House has an agenda for our children. What kind of agenda? Mandatory federal and state daycare programs, for starters. Pre-school daycare for all of America's children, and absolutely mandatory, because they want to bring these little children in and save them from the parents, teach them the New Age anti-Christian philosophy."
